Offline gifts received at our state office will be processed and added to your Plunge page (personal or team). Changes will be reflected on your Plunge page within five business days of our office receiving the donations. If you make your own deposits for a local Area Program or LETR agency, make sure to send a record of your deposit to the Richmond office address if you want to receive credit on your online page. Please send copies of the checks that were deposited when possible so donations can be posted properly.

In order to receive credit on your Plunge page and for incentives, donations must be received at our state office by January 24 (Virginia Beach), February 14 (New River & Northern Virginia), or May 30 (Richmond). If you receive a donation in the weeks leading up to your Plunge event, we strongly encourage you to bring them with you to registration. Donations received after the cutoff date will be processed after the event.
